Diagnostic Criteria of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

Severity is based on social communication impairments and restricted, repetitive patterns of behavior

- A. Persistent deficits in Social Communication and Social Interaction across multiple contexts
- B. Restrictive, repetitive pattern of behavior, interests or activitiesC. Symptoms must be present in the early developmental period (may be masked by learned strategies in later life)
- D. Symptoms cause clinically significant impairment in social, occupational or other important areas of current functioning
- E. These disturbances are not explained by intellectual disability (intellectual developmental disorder) or global

developmental delay

- With or without accompanying language impairment
- With or without accompanying intellectual impairment associated with a known medical or genetic condition or environmental factor
- With catatonia
